Hans Heyson (South Australia)

Pro Hart (Broken Hill).

Carl Duldig. One of Australia's first Modernist artists. (Burke Road, East Malvern, Vic.) Appointment required.

John and Sunday Reid's home at Heidi in Bulleen, Victoria, can be visited to see where a number of artists including Nolan, Tucker and Hester worked for a while.

Of special interest is that one of the author's text books *Art Studies*, is in Brett Whiteley's small collection in his Studio (see below).
